Member Information and Policies

- ✓ Membership runs from April 1 to October 15. A \$5 cart fee (good for the entire day) will be charged to members playing after October 15.
- Members, guests, and public players alike must check in with the golf shop staff and sign the daily sign-in sheet before playing the golf course. No exceptions. To ensure a position on the tee box for you and your guests, tee times are highly recommended. To book tee times online, please create an account in the Tee Times section of our website using the name printed on your membership card. Please note that even though a credit card is required to create an account, this card is not charged.
- ✓ To minimize wait time and help our staff keep things moving smoothly, members are required to bring their membership cards each time they come to play golf. Replacement cards can be obtained for \$2 in the pro shop.
- ✓ For the benefit of all players, our members will be committed to playing the holes in the designated order or as prescribed by the golf shop staff as necessary.
- Our members agree to set the example for all guests and public play by staying out of all areas on the course marked as ground under repair or otherwise protected for the sake of improved playability for members and guests of Lake Mills Golf Club.
- ✓ Open play is defined as any time there is not an organized event (i.e., outings, leagues, club tournaments, etc.).
- Members, guests, and public players will not play the golf course during periods when a portion of the holes (or the entire course) is closed due to weather, special events, or golf course maintenance.
- Lake Mills Golf Club will be solely responsible for distribution of all alcoholic beverages at the facility. As a member, you will agree that you and your guests will not bring alcoholic beverages onto the property that were not purchased at Lake Mills Golf Club. This is consistent with Wisconsin law.
